

Please continue to save any U.S. and foreign stamps for our program. It cost you nothing but a few minutes of your time to cut the stamps from the envelope and drop them in the box.




With the number of Veterans we have in Grand Horizons and the residents that offer us moral support we should be able to gather numerous stamps to help the Vets


